## Call for fair go on Diggers super

A COALITION of defence organisations has accused Julia Gillard of hypocrisy for attending the funerals of Diggers but of failing to implement a more generous indexation formula for military superannuants.

In a letter to the Prime Minister, defence welfare groups call on Ms Gillard to enact fairer indexation for military super.

Spearheading a "Fair Go" campaign, the Alliance of Defence Service Organisations

wants the indexing of military superannuation based on the same formula used to assess the aged pension. ADSO express "disgust" at what they claim is the federal government's betrayal of former service personnel.

The cost of changing the formula would be less than \$20 million a year but would benefit 53,000 recipients of Defence Force Retirement and Death Benefits scheme.
